Balance and symmetry – equally well Proportioned					
Disposition					
Head – Pleasing, proportioned, refined					
Eyes – Large and set well apart, color, sclera					
Ears – Small, well shaped and set correctly					
Teeth – Correct bite					
Throatlatch – Refined and neat					
Neck – Long, thin, head set, high tie in at the base, low out of the withers					
Shoulder – Long, well angled					
Withers –defined					
Back – not to long, straight and strong					
Loin – wide and well muscled					
Underline – long, sloping to flanks					
Length of hip – long with good tail set					
Length of hip to hock – long					
Muscling – powerful, wide stifle					
Heart girth – deep, great circumference, with wide sprung ribs					
Front legs – straight, square, refined					
Forearm – long, well muscled					
Chest – good V and carry down					
Knee – clean, strong					
Cannon – short, flat, good bone					
Pastern – good length and slope					
Foot – well shaped, good heel, adequate size					
Rear legs – true, straight, squarely under body, refined but strong					
Stifle – full					
Gaskin – well muscled, long carry down					
Hocks – clean and strong, well set					
Action – flat, sweepy, tracks straight
